
Danison will present to Council a synopsis incorporating the outcome of this meetings discussion.

- Use as primary housing on a lot, must meet all setbacks, have all utilities (water, sewer, garbage, and electricity), apply for building permit, only in R2 & R3 zoning districts, may be skirted, must have current registration/license.
- Use of on property when constructing a building with an active building permit for a time period of only two years.
